CERTIFICATE OF PROFICIENCY WORKSHEET EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE, BASIC

The certificate of proficiency for Emergency Medical Technician - Basic is designed to train individuals to rapidly recognize, assess, and treat medical and trauma-related emergencies. It is based on guidelines from the Department of Transportation and is required of all ambulance service personnel prior to employment. This certificate serves as a prerequisite to the EMT - Intermediate and Paramedic courses.
